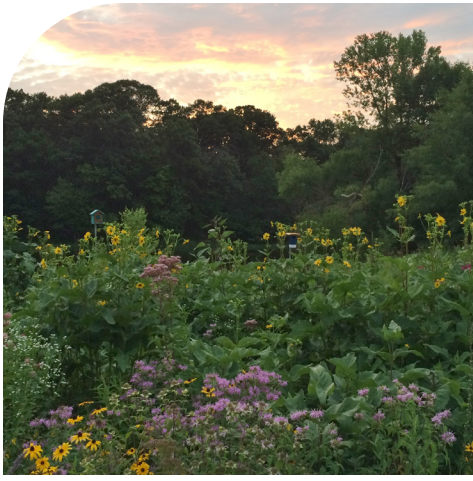


Trees and forests learning series

You are welcome to bring extra art supplies if you'd like. Hennepin County foresters will guide the workshop and offer helpful tips as you create. You'll make artwork to take home and learn about the trees and plants that the seeds came from. This workshop will take place in the Meeting Room at Hopkins Library.

Selecting trees for a pollinator garden

**Wednesday, July 8 from 4:30 to 6 p.m.
at Wolfe Park in St. Louis Park**

Learn how to choose the right tree species to include in a residential pollinator garden. We will discuss the key factors to consider when selecting tree species. Then we will tour small pollinator gardens at Wolfe Park to see commonly used plants and trees. We will meet outside the Wolfe Park Building. This workshop will take place entirely outdoors on paved trails.

Tree identification introduction

**Thursday, June 18 from 4 to 5:30 p.m.
at Kylawn Park in Brooklyn Center**

Learn the basics of how to identify common trees in Hennepin County. This workshop will take place entirely outdoors on both paved and unpaved trails. We will meet in the parking lot near the corner of 61st Avenue North and Lee Avenue North.
